## ECUMENICAL PRAYER SERVICE WITH TAIZÉ SONGS

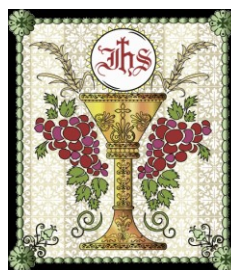

## OVER 18: A DOCUMENTARY ABOUT PORNOGRAPHY

Despite its prevalence—and the faulty beliefs of some, even those of goodwill, that it is harmless—pornography remains a largely un-discussed scourge of the modern world. The facts are that 9 in 10 boys and 6 in 10 girls have encountered pornographic material by the age of 18, most by the age of 14. Nearly half of teens have created sexually explicit images of themselves and sent them to another. New psychological and sociological research is exposing this for the incredible danger that it is; it is misshaping the minds and relationships of a generation. ***Over 18*** is a compelling and eye-opening documentary that explores this pernicious evil and the true effects it has on young people, parents, families and those involved victimized by pornography and other forms of sexual exploitation. The Diocese has made this documentary available to us, and we will have a showing on ***Wednesday, May 30<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. in the PLC.*** All those with young or teenage children (or grandchildren) are encouraged to attend (***the presentation is suitable for adults only.***)
