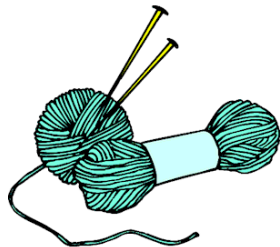


Chrism Mass
