INTERESTED IN BECOMING CATHOLIC?

3 people have begun the Rite of Christian Initiation (RCIA) process for this year.

RCIA is the process by which those who have little knowledge of the Catholic faith and have not been baptized, are usually invited to participate in a process of formation in the parish - culminating with Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist.

Those who are already baptized in other Christian denominations, but who would like to enter into the Full Communion of the Catholic Church, generally follow a similar process, though it may be shorter in duration.
