Dear family,

Que viva fiesta!! I hope everyone enjoys this weekend's celebration of Las Fiestas de Santa Ana Y Santiago, let us ask our patrons for all that our community needs and have faith that God will hear the prayers from humble hearts.

In the Mass, right before the "Our Father" is recited, the priest introduces the prayer by saying, "At the Savior's command and formed by divine teaching, we dare to say..." It seems such a strange choice of words for such a familiar prayer, why must it be a "dare" to say a prayer so close to our hearts? Perhaps because we are saying something amazing when we refer to God as "Father." The relationship between creator and creature is totally transformed by this one word, because it means that God has adopted us. With no need for us to complete Him, in all of His power and knowledge, God has decided that He wants us to be with Him, and treats us as His own. The implications this brings our life are amazing, if only we interiorize them. As powerful as the clauses are in this prayer, they are even more powerful when one realizes that they are not making a prayer to an unknown force, nor is he making petition as one would throw a penny into a wishing well: taking a blind chance. Dearest family, we have been a great gift of intimacy with our God and we must take advantage of this offer. Let us never cease to approach our God with warmth and confidence, while always giving Him respect.
