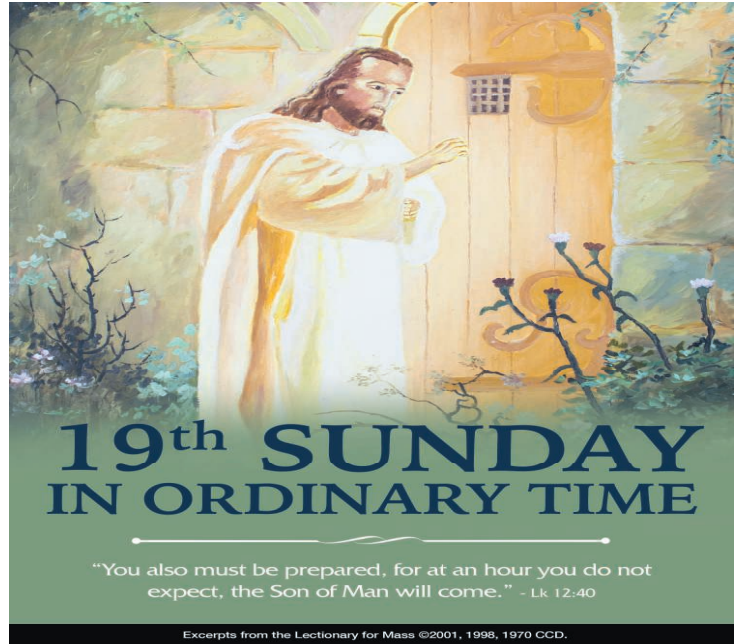

Pastor's Desk*

Dearest family,

I am thrilled that our parish can rejoice with Fr. Andrew Ifele and his congregation of Questa in the dedication of their new Church on August 14th at 12:00pm. Now more than ever it's important we pray together and support each other as Catholics. Our neighbors have suffered missing a worship space and now they have erected a worthy temple in which to worship Our Lord. Therefore, I am canceling the 1030 Mass on August 14th so that our deacons, parishioners and myself can attend this Mass to be celebrated by Archbishop Wester. Please join in a beautiful and historic celebration. The idea of "stewardship" and of being "a steward" has a long history and foundation in our faith. A steward is someone who is left to care, tend and protect people, land or things entrusted to them. Starting in the beginning in the book of Genesis Adam and Eve, the first persons, we made stewards of God's creation. Among all his duties, a steward has many rights as well, except for one: the rights associated with ownership. For us Catholics it is theologically incorrect and sinful for us to view nature and others as our personal possession. This is not to say that we do not have possessions or use resources, but the Christian must always keep it firm in his mind that God alone is owner of all the things we have been given and so we should move about our lives with a view to His will. It is a thin line between stewardship and ownership when one is given responsibility and so we must be vigilant to weed out any tendency we have for the need to control and possess the gifts we have been given. In other words, we should approach God's creation like we do God, with a sense of mystery and reverence, lest we make the huge mistake of possibly overstepping boundaries and hurting others. Jesus warns against this danger when He corrects Peter for thinking he is above the law. With Jesus, He could care less about our ability to flaunt our social connections and their ability to provide influence. For whatever order He gives His people, He gives it to all of them unilaterally, with no exceptions. Let us be docile to His will for our betterment and the betterment of those we serve. God has a glorious plan for all of us and it's much better than any plan of our own!
