Year of Mercy Corner:

There is a misconception that mercy and merciful people are weak. It is a presumption of many that it takes a "soft" person to show mercy, but this could not be further from the truth. Mercy is dangerous and risky business. On the one hand choosing to act mercifully means that one has to contend with all those who differ in opinion. To argue with certain people who seek vengeance or who comfortably avoid helping others and to deal with their disapproval is not always easy. On the other hand, there is a risk that mercy we show others may not be received with gratitude. The merciful one many never make a name for herself or himself. Jesus in all his goodness to us takes this risk constantly and in an ultimate way from the cross: a beautiful act of love that many still mock or reject. Knowing this and knowing the risk, Jesus did it anyway.

Dear family,

Anyone remotely familiar with the Gospels know that they contain many instances where Jesus is found as the healer. From those with leprosy, to blindness and even death, Jesus is seen helping many people and restoring their lives. Often though, there is always a deeper meaning, message or healing that is highlighted in the passage. In today's Gospel, ten men approach Jesus for healing and are healed, but only one has a realization that someone has helped him. He feels overwhelming gratitude and joy and gives credit where credit is due, falling at the feet of Jesus. For the other nine men, they saw and seized an opportunity for a better life and who could blame them for taking it. For the tenth man, he saw the healing of Jesus as a grace and a gift. For this man, he was not merely healed, but this was one experience he will never forget because it has changed his life and filled his heart with hope. Yes we are called to show gratitude, yes, we need to be in the habit of thanking God especially for all His blessings, but more than this we are called to imitate Jesus in helping others and showing them mercy. Like in this case, we may not get the thanks we deserve, our work as Christians is to touch the heart with the love of God and wherever we see a chance to do this, it must be done. Jesus' compassion meant everything to this man, our actions could do the same for someone else.
