"Did you know?"

Did you know that during the season of Lent, the Church asks us to very simply adorn our churches and worship spaces. This is because entering the desert with Jesus and journeying toward Easter, we are asked to live in a simple way recalling the poverty of our limitations and the utter reliance we have on God to provide for and save us. The "rubrics" or rules governing liturgical law tell us that the altar should not be adorned with flowers and that minimal decoration should accompany the worship space. You may also notice other symbols of the season such as more solemn music and the banners of purple which represent contrition for sins and our repentance. The Church in Her wisdom knows that as humans we need physical and palpable reminders of our faith and because the décor of a church corresponds to certain seasons, we express what we believe in symbols. Let us match the décor of our parish church as we seek to simplify our lives of things that matter less in light of what matters more!

Dear family,

As we continue through Lent, we see Jesus continue to heal people dealing with different wounds, last Sunday we saw Jesus interact with the woman at the well who found herself suffering from wounds of alienation having been ostracized for her own community. Today's "patient" however has not only been alienated but is invisible to people. He is a blind beggar who has no voice and because no one considers his presence or needs. Even the apostle's before knowing anything of his life or story immediately judge him based on his handicap. But at the touch of Jesus this man's whole life was about to change. After healing the man's blindness, Jesus exits the scene only for the man to be questioned, harassed and persecuted. Through all the questioning and unfair treatment, the man actually recovers his voice as well while defending his truth. He begins to grow in his faith as the questioning forces him to unpack his encounter with Jesus leading him to believe that Jesus is definitely an agent of heaven. When Jesus appears again at the end of the passage, the man's convictions are validated and he comes to meet Our Lord once more in a moment of gratitude and joy. Sometimes God heals us through His apparent absence in our lives. Forcing us to walk upright and erect, we learn that despite the negativity and disrespect of the world that we are called to be dignified children of God. Let us remember to be the voice for the voiceless and help those who feel invisible to recognize their worth before Almighty God.
