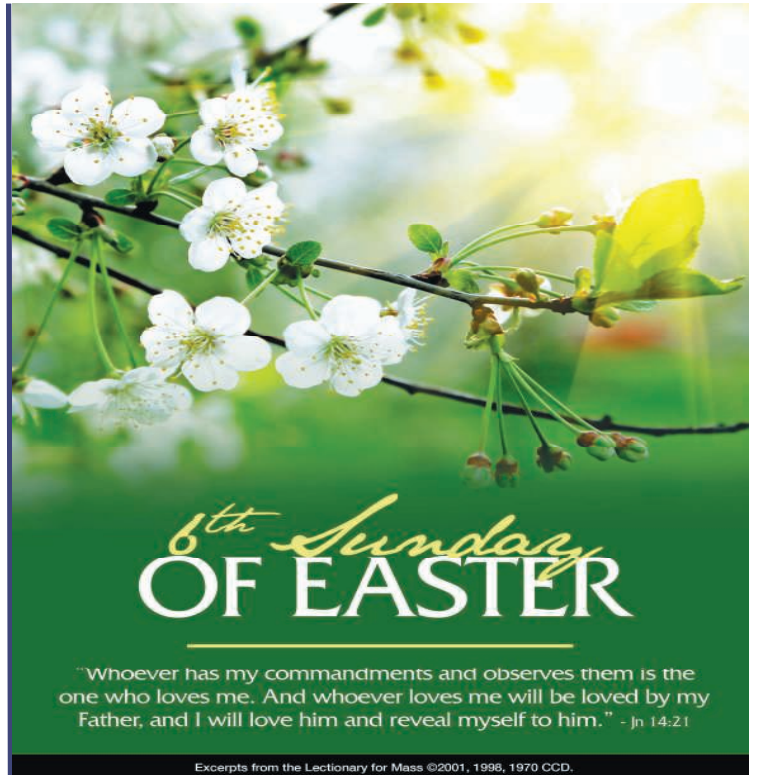

## Liturgical Tidbits

Sometimes when there is a procession involved in a liturgy or service the question comes up concerning its order. I can remember a few times when I was asked to be first or placed somewhere in the middle in a distinguished place of honor, but I had to decline. Notice any Sunday Mass procession, the deacons and priests are always dead last. Why is this? It doesn't seem to make any sense. In the 20<sup>th</sup> chapter of the Gospel of Matthew Our Lord teaches the disciples by a parable about His style of leadership. Essentially, He is fair and surprisingly generous with everyone, even those who do not seem to deserve the fairness. Not looking at one's tenure or track record, He gives to all what He wishes, but is always at least fair. He finishes this with the statement, the last will be first and the first will be last. What? Does this make sense? Not according to many ways of thinking which consider a person's merit based on what they have done. It usually doesn't make sense when I mention that I take the last place in line, but this is not God's wisdom. The servant of God gladly takes his place last in line as a reminder than in some way God lifted him up when he was stumbling and came into the rat race...even dead last.

Dear family,

When many people think about our faith or hear the word "Catholicism" immediately they think "rules!" It's a common mistake for someone to equate our faith with a set of rules. "Let your religion be less of a theory and more of a love affair," said G.K. Chesterton. For anyone caught up in the "love affair" of their faith journey, they know that the rules are a secondary reality to the relationship they possess with their God. We do not believe in a set of rules, we instead have been transformed by an encounter with God and have discovered our true identity as His children. As such, our life looks different, and the "rules" are guidelines for how such a person acts. In today's Gospel, Our Lord talks about how we are adopted by God. After the promise of the Advocate (Holy Spirit), He tells us that we will not be orphaned, but be caught up in the relationship between Him and the Father. How dignified is this? Our destiny is not to follow rules, our destiny is to possess the life of God, which we already possess now in some way by our baptism. Immediately after this, Jesus says "Whoever has my commandments and observes them is the one who loves me. And whoever loves me will be loved by my Father, and I will love him and reveal myself to him." Our following God's commandments is indicative of our covenant with Him. So how do we help this problem of so many misunderstanding our faith in terms of rules? We make good impressions ourselves! When the moment is right, the Holy Spirit moves you, speak about your faith and your relationship to God. You just may inspire someone to look at it differently. The truth is our faith is actually quite amazing, let's portray that to the world.
