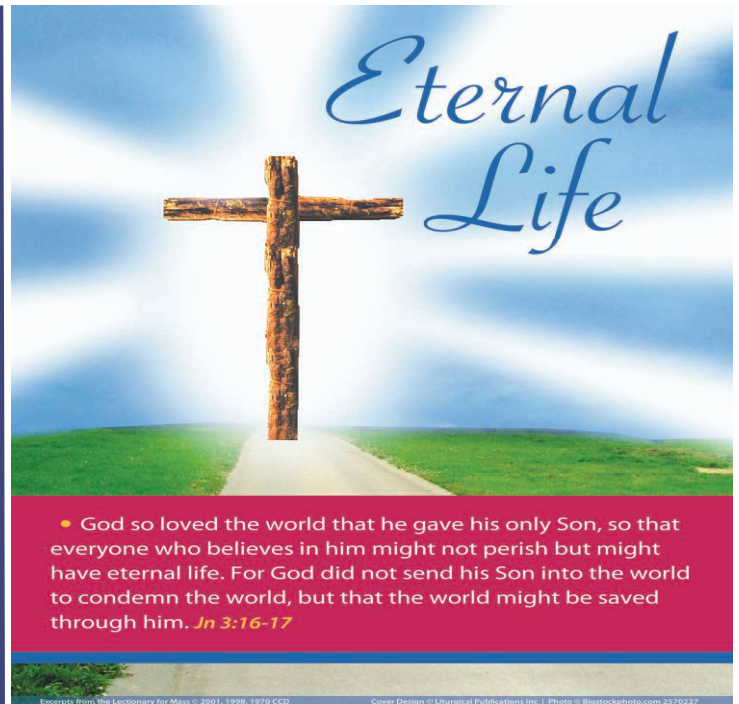

Liturgical Tidbits

Today as we celebrate the Trinity we see that the liturgy of the Church is inundated with our belief in a Triune God. Remember the old adage: *Lex Orandi, Lex Credendi*. Roughly translated it means: As we pray, so we believe. Now consider how much the Trinity is mentioned alone in the Mass. Every prayer is addressed to a member of the Trinity, mainly the Father because the priest is usually acting in the person of God the Son. This means that the effects of God's grace during the liturgy is not merely the result of one entity sending us a message, but we are caught up in the eternal relationship between the three persons who include us in their love and truth. We are afforded this honor by the fact that all of us were baptized in the name of the "Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." From the beginning of the Mass until the final blessing we are part of a great conversation, a familial, though divine gathering. How blest are we. Remember next time you are at Mass or any liturgy, to bring the fullness of your life and the context of your life to that conversation. He's waiting to hear from you.

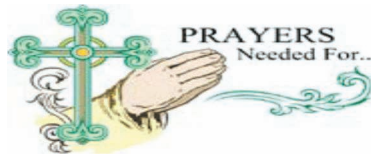

Dear family,

This Sunday we celebrate the great feast of Holy Trinity. The Catechism calls the teaching of the Holy Trinity the most fundamental teaching of our Faith. Perhaps this seems like a common sense assertion given that the Trinity concerns the nature of God Himself. But what import is the doctrine of the Trinity today in our context. I think the Gospel for this feast today explains it well: "God so loved the world that He sent His only begotten Son..." The Trinity teaches us by our very existence and now redemption that God is loving and wants to include us in His life. I feel that so many times we are tempted, because of hardship or erroneous ideas that God is very hands off or that He sees us as burdens. God's revelation about Himself is comforting and consoling news that does not allow room for images of God that project human brokenness and pettiness on Him. Indeed, our God is an awesome God!
