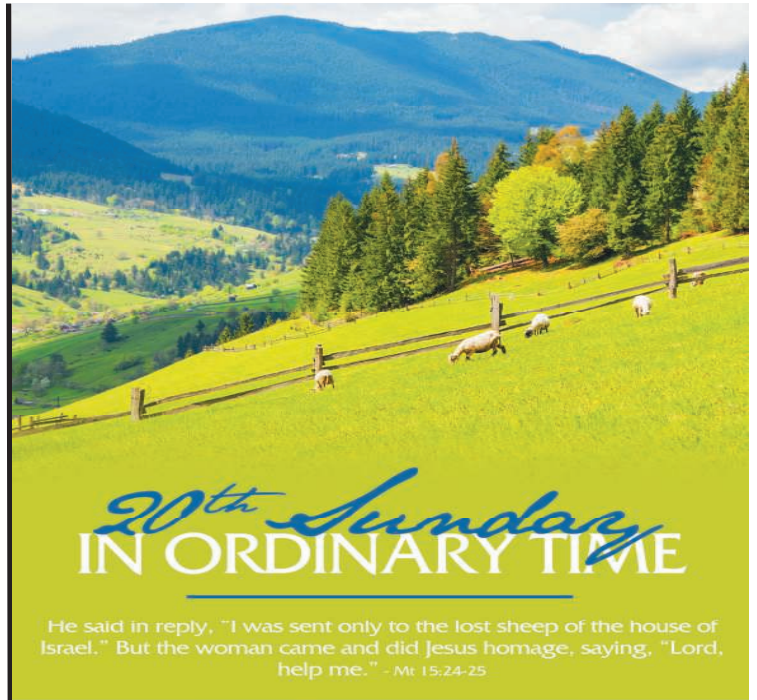

*Liturgical Tidbits*

A custom among Catholics in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament is to genuflect. A genuflection is when one in an act of respect and reverence bends their right knee keeping one's back straight to the object of respect. In Ancient Rome, soldiers addressing their superiors and messengers addressing members of senate or an emperor would genuflect to them as a sign of respect. Always remember, friends, all of our ritualistic actions have a deep meaning that relate to our most dearest convictions and beliefs. Whenever you see a tabernacle or sanctuary lamp, indicated the presence of the Blessed Sacrament make sure to genuflect if you can, he deserves our respect.

Dear family, We give a warm welcome this weekend to our former pastor and a caring priest, Fr. Brito. Not too long ago, at a funeral we both celebrated, Father asked me if we could swap parishes for the weekend. I thought at the time, "What a novel idea!" What a neat chance to see a different part of the diocese which is made possible from a swap. I am sad I didn't think of this earlier. Fr. Brito will get to visit with all of you and I will get to visit with former parishioners in Santa Fe, including at St. Anne's where I was once

assigned as a seminarian. In today's Gospel we have the example of the Canaanite woman who approached Jesus for healing for her daughter. It's important to understand that this woman was not a Jew, some of Jesus' own people would even consider being around a person like this woman, because she was a pagan, would make one unclean. Jesus' words to her might seem harsh to our 21st century, politically correct ears. However, Jesus is only explaining to the woman that she had no legitimate explanation of His help. In the end, as is His fashion, Jesus does not merely "work miracles," but uses the opportunity to draw those involved into a deeper faith. In this case, Our Lord helps the woman to understand that she must name Him as Lord and claim that with her words and with faith. Often times as a priest, there are those who approach us to possible use the Church or the name of Christ in ways that benefit them. And while we should always be kind and charitable, it is best we help each other to think deeper and perhaps even using people's emotions to draw them into deeper faith in Our Lord. Miracles are amazing things to behold, but nothing compared to the miracle of a person grafted completely to his or her God! Let us be humble and seek our God not just with our requests, but a desire to walk closer with Him. In His joy, Fr. Daniel
