

Dear family,

Due to our current political situation in the world, there is a lot of division. Our tendency is this kind of context to step on eggshells. We don't want to "rock the boat" or "make any waves." Our sentiments are understandable, but at what cost? Of course as Christians we are never to be hateful, rude or mean with those who disagree with us. However, we do more of a disservice to actual dialogue and problem solving

when we fail to voice our convictions. Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI once said that the world suffers from a "dictatorship of relativism." Relativism is when one decides, directly or indirectly, that there is no absolutely truth. For the sake of being "tolerant" we sometimes throw away any semblance of the truth, and when this become so popular, then anyone left with convictions that are near and dear to his/her heart is left with no voice. In our Gospel today we see St. Peter make a very bold statement about Our Lord, namely, that He is the Son of God and Chosen One promised to God's people. Jesus likewise makes a bold statement, giving Peter great authority and responsibility. The belief in the Supremacy of Jesus Christ and the authority possessed by His Church are things we Catholics are called to proclaim and protect. When we enter into dialogue with those of other faith traditions we have to recall our identity as Catholic Christians in order to really engage into a fruitful conversation. So let's do away with statements about our faith being one legitimate path among many or Our Lord being at His essence a powerful moral teacher.


