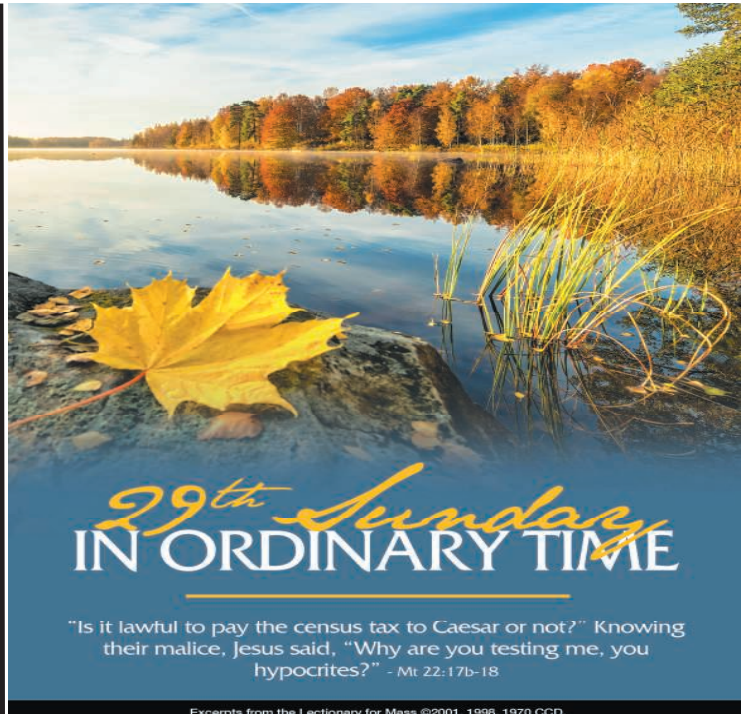

Dear family,

Have you ever found yourself in a "catch twenty two" situation? While we are faced with decisions every day, a catch twenty two is when one is faced with two or more options, all of which will result in some negative consequence. Jesus seemingly faces this sort of dilemma today when the Pharisees give him yet another challenge. "Is it lawful to pay the census tax to Caesar or not?" If He says "yes," then they can accuse Our Lord of not siding with the faith leaders and therefore choosing government over belief. If He says "no," then they have the Jesus in the perfect trap and can accuse Him of being anti-government. Our Lord not only answers this dilemma, but decides to take the moment to teach them and anyone else present as well. He asks about the image and inscription on the currency and advises them to "repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God." As Christians we are called to be law abiding people and "pay our dues" where it is lawful. But the truth He implies by this response is even more amazing. If the image was the deciding factor as to the responsibility to the state, what does that say about us, who are made in the image and likeness of God? Like the coin with Caesar's image, we also bear an image on our soul: God Himself! Are we paying our whole due to God, who has made us and called us to build His kingdom on earth? Are we giving our all? The answer to these is up to us, but first we must always understand, we are not our own!
