

Whenever I encounter someone who has been in ministry longer than me, I always try and ask them what they have learned and what wisdom they can offer a young priest. I have had some memorable advice, but there is one nugget I will never forget. The pastor at my first summer assignment as a seminarian told me once: "Never hire anyone based on skills, skills can always be learned. Only choose people who love God and His people, because love cannot be learned, it is either there or not. Father made it very clear, love is primary, love is foundational. This is exactly what Jesus is getting at in today's Gospel. Primarily we are not a people who only follow rules or are asked to stay in the lines between virtue and vice. Primarily we are called to love, and God's entire teaching is based on this. In other words, "love" should be the reason we seek to fulfill God's law. Perhaps this primacy of love is seen better when put in the negative. If one seeks to follow God's law and do charitable works for others out of fear of punishment or in order to impress others, can we really call that love, do those actions have the same worth? Apparently not, because love is either there or it is not, and love counts. Let us examine our motives and seek to purify them by putting on God's endless love.

I will be leaving on Friday in order to make some visits in the Midwest. As you may remember, I did my undergraduate seminary studies at the Pontifical College Josephinum in Columbus, OH. I will be going back to that part of the country to visit with a former classmate who has recently joined the Holy Cross Fathers, the order that runs Notre Dame University and many others. I will miss you all and will be praying for you as I ask you pray for me.


