Dear family,

Do you have hope? Often in a bleak situation, not unlike what our world is currently facing between violence and corruption, possessing hope can mean the difference between life and death (even just in terms of morale). In our second reading St. Paul exhorts us that even in the face of death we Christians should bear the unique mark of hope, a rarity among those who only have recourse to their devices and within human limits. What a better or more appropriate time to take hold of our lineage as sons and daughters of God to take ownership of the hope we possess, a hope that has conquered death, a hope not cut off by our limitations but rooted in the heart of the limitless God who never gives up on us!
