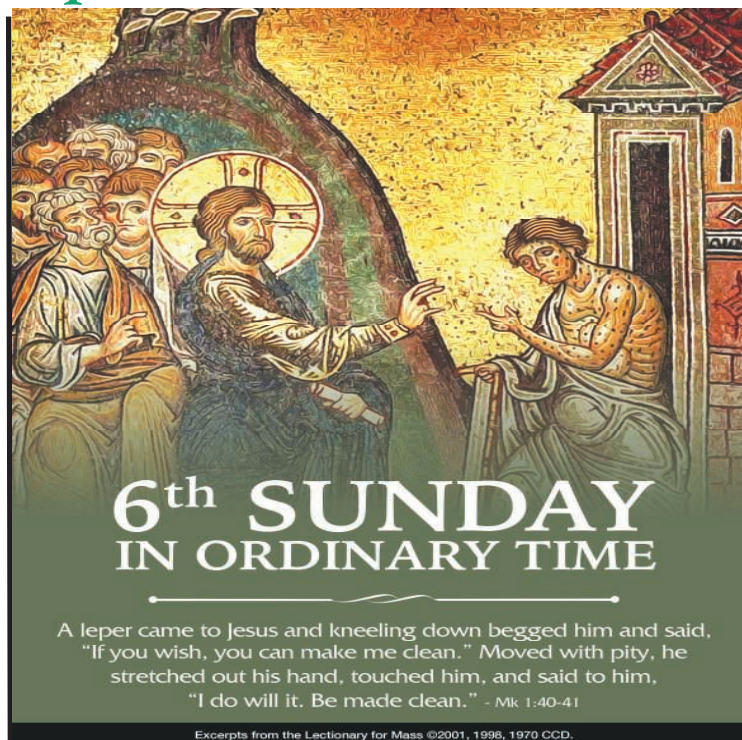

Due to the severity of the Flu Season, the Archdiocese will be taking the following steps in regard to the Celebration Of the Mass:

During the Sign of Peace instead of shaking hands or hugging, as is practiced in some parishes, it would be best to simply nod your head and avoid bodily contact.

When praying the Our Father, please do not hold hands. Simply extend your hands toward heaven or fold your hands.

Holy Communion will not be received under both species, just the Consecrated Host and not the Chalice.

The Archdiocese of Santa Fe is encouraging the reception of the Consecrated Host in the hands. This directive is aimed at limiting contact with saliva and thus limiting the spread of the flu virus to save lives.

pastor's Corner

Dear family,

It has become the common definition of “strength” as a state or individual where no weakness is present. This has been especially pushed on men as a way of proving to the world their worth and ability. The Gospel of Jesus, however, tells us differently. As we see in today’s proclamation, true strength lies not as an absence of weakness, but in bringing that weakness before the feet of Christ and allowing the Divine Physician to heal our wounds. This takes faith and humility. We must be able to have faith to echo the leper who said to Jesus, “If you wish, you can make me clean.” We must also have humility like the leper who kneeling before Our Lord, presented his wounds. We need to be able to come to Jesus vulnerable and broken if He is to heal us. The virtues of faith and humility are two great examples of what we can work on during Lent, which is right around the corner. Let us place our sometime broken or imperfect selves into Jesus’ hands and hear His reply, “I do will it. Be made clean.”
