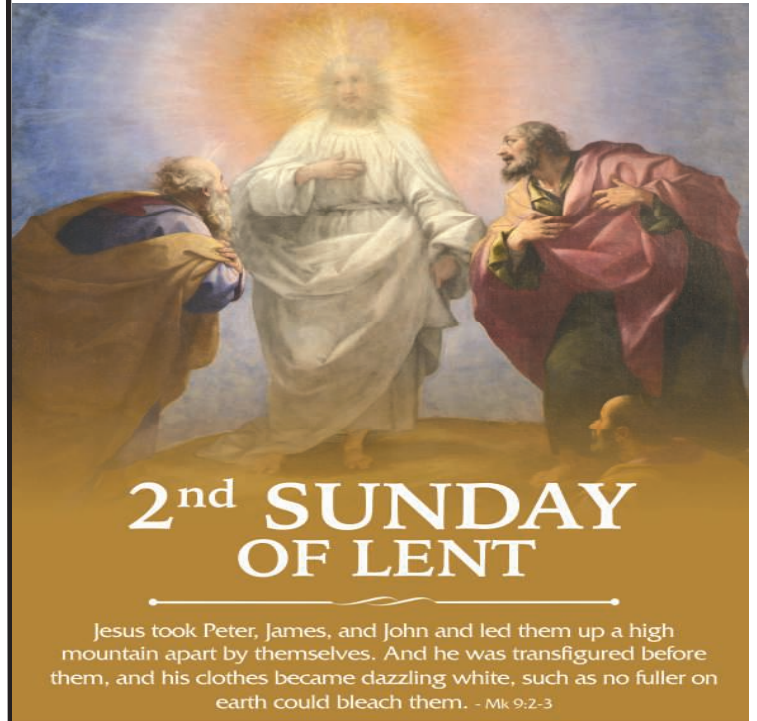

pastor's Corner

Dear Family,

How much do you trust God? Like any relationship, trust only becomes an issue when there is something at stake or we feel as if we have been neglected. It is fine enough for one to confess things like love or trust for another in beautiful and flowing words, but when that testament is put to the test we fear there is something precious to lose. This must have been what Abraham felt when God asked him to seemingly sacrifice his son: his beloved and his legacy. As we find out, in the end, God did not want him to sacrifice his son, but his fear. He wanted Abraham to throw himself completely into His arms. His willingness to listen to God gave Abraham a more complete trust in Him and His plan for Abraham's life. With God, sacrifice without love and trust is not true sacrifice, because it should take place in a relationship of concern for the other. How about our trust in God? He has given us so much, including His own Son, the very thing in the end he did not ask from Abraham. What attachment or fear is keeping you from trusting God? Growing in trust is never easy, especially when our trust has been shaken by a bad relationship. God has given us so much reason to entrust our lives for Him, why not start the conversation with Him about your fears in following after Him. He will console you and empower you to follow Him!
