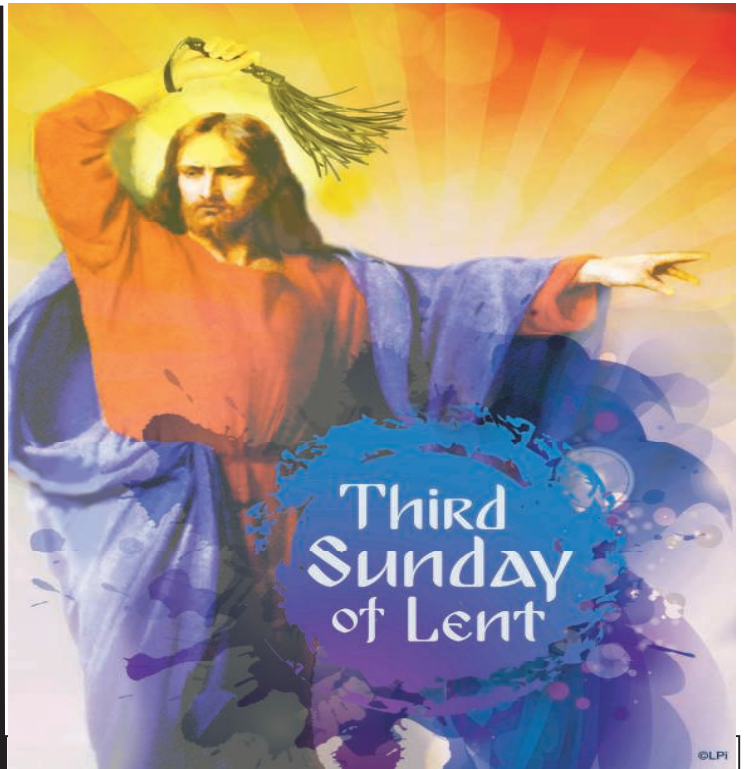

pastor's Corner

Dear family,

In today's Gospel we meet a Jesus that is forgotten, ignored, and "swept under the rug." When people usually picture Jesus, especially as portrayed by some popular Christian personalities, He is sweet, amicable, and someone akin to Barney the Dinosaur: telling everyone what they want to hear and granting everyone's wishes. The problem is that this is not the Jesus given to us in Divine Revelation. He is loving, kind, most definitely compassionate, but He is also determined and committed to justice. He is also firm and often gives people not what they want, but what they need. By not merely satisfying their immediate desires, but "pruning" and stretching them, even to the point of pain, Jesus demands disciples who are willing to learn the way of His sacrificial love.

This is the Jesus we meet in today's Gospel who defends His Father's house. Jesus is angry and has no qualms about expressing that anger. He shows that anger can be righteous. He shows us that we are to stand up to the injustices around us. Most importantly, Jesus displays for us today that we must defend God as a priority in our life, wherever His name is disrespected. So many people continue and under self-imposed constraint to allow the temples of their own heart to be ransacked by thieves and imposters, isn't this Lent a time to drive out the injustice in our life so as to leave those spaces for true worship and for God's presence?
