Pastor's Corner

Dear family,

How do you picture God? For many, they love the image of the shepherd found through the old and new testament, most powerfully when Jesus compares Himself to a shepherd that, “lays down his life for his sheep.” It’s a comforting and powerful image, especially to those who find themselves suffering with great or prolonged turmoil in their life. And no doubt, this is one of the intended effects that Jesus intends when using such an image. But let me ask the question: Have any of you actually met a shepherd? When images depicting Christ as the good shepherd are done he has perfectly flowing blonde hair and almost daintily can be seen frolicking with his sheep, perhaps even a cute little lamb on his shoulders. This is too much. Real shepherds are strong, fit, and often times rough looking men. As Jesus points out, a real shepherd is someone willing to face danger, work hard and above all sacrifice of himself. Where do you see “dainty” in that depiction? Look, I get it, we need to hold on to images that bring us comfort, but this shepherd is in it to see us through, while protecting and guiding us, not while necessary always looking pretty. God cares enough to gets his hands dirty taking care of us, let us be attentive to his call!
