pastor's Corner

Dear family,

With new technology coming out all the time, it is hard to wrap my head around everything we are capable of doing. Even during my lifetime, technology has grown at such a high rate that I am constantly surprised by what invention will come out next. We have machines that can vacuum the carpet, give us the daily news and weather by voice command, and even call for a ride. Along with all of these capabilities of technology, the world of social media has to be among the most amazing. With a list of apps one can virtually share every aspect of their lives, except maybe one: his or her heart. With so many capabilities to share, comment on and post information about our lives and world, it’s hard to keep straight the difference between the person and the machine: something I access and control and someone I affect. We probably see this gap made so obvious when we think of how easy it is to express comfort or contempt for someone. In a matter of seconds one can drag a person’s good name through the thickest of muds or express support during a time of trial. But what is it worth? The Church recognizes how technology can share the power of the Gospel. As a powerful tool, technology can accomplish what in the past took so much longer. The price we often pay for this expediency, however, is the ability to truly connect with each other in a way that sustains us and which our dignity requires. To say that we send our “thoughts and prayers” to someone who is hurting is a nice gesture but what does it actually do and what does it cost us: not very much! In today’s Gospel, Jesus encounters crowds following him and he recognizes their need for guidance and compassion. The English does not do justice to what Jesus’s feels when he sees the crowds. More than having “pity” on them, his whole body is moved with emotion at their suffering and so he does something about it. No doubt it was these acts of compassion that made a huge impression on the Apostles and everyone who came into contact with Jesus and which inspired them to do the same for countless others. To follow the mandate of Our Lord to love means actually encountering others in their brokenness and accompanying them through their darkness, and that cannot be done for us, only by us.
