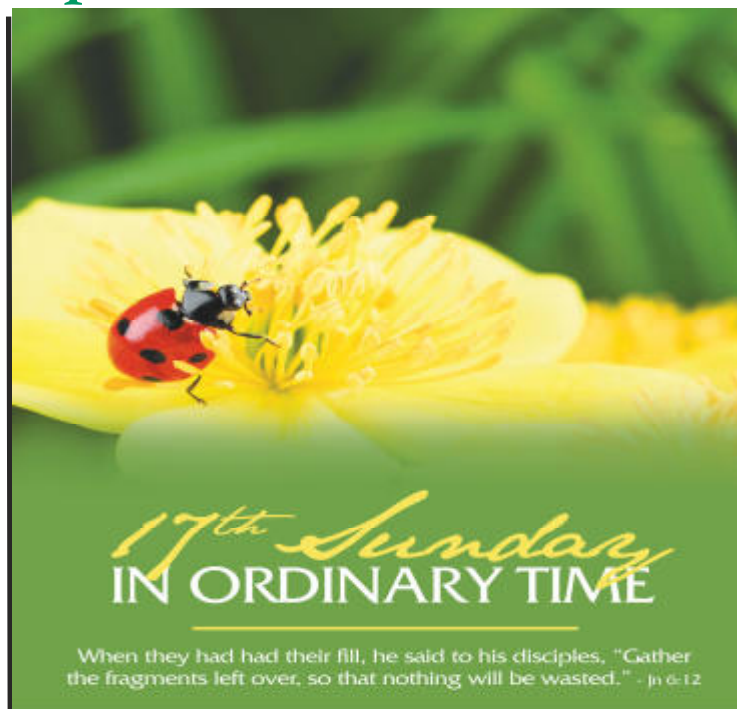

pastor's Corner

Dear family,

When I was first assigned here, in addition to every other consideration, just moving into the rectory was quite the experience. Where would I put my things, what furniture belonged to the parish and would stay and what was being taken away. How would I decorate the rooms, how would I decorate my room? This, after all, was the first experience I ever had of taking care of a home and living alone at that. It was an adjustment, to say the least. It was during this time that I thanked God for the female friends in my life who have a much better handle than me on decorating. I remember in looking at my living room that I was having a conversation with one of my spiritual sisters. She asked me what I was going to do with the beautiful Sacred Heart statue in one of nichos. I mentioned that maybe it would be better suited in a classroom in the school or in one of the capillas and she stopped me mid-sentence: "No! Don't! Leave Him there, you are going to need Him around, especially on the hard days." How right she was! I find myself venerating that statue all the time and talking to Him about what's going on, my worries for the parish or other concerns. I feel free to express my frustrations to Him or just thank Him for beauty of my life and for being blessed to pastor such a beautiful parish. But what I like most about this image is that He is pointing to His heart as if to say, "Daniel, look here! Quit watching the distractions of your thoughts, fears or illusions of your own control. The answer is here, because what is here is everything you're looking for."

In today's Gospel, Jesus and the gang run into a major problem: tons of people with nothing to eat. The apostles, as they usually do, freak out. They scramble and rack their brains to find a solution, one focusing on a lack of money, the other on the lack of resources. Only a small boy with a small sack lunch of a few fish and loaves turns to Jesus in his poverty and offers Him what he had. For all the drama and stress the apostles went through, they not once turned to Jesus; not once did they see the solution standing right in front of them. It can be a real "test" of our faith when we try to take everything on our shoulders, leaving no room for God's grace to work and it is in the madness that we need to look to Jesus who points to His heart: "here is your answer, here lies the only solution you'll ever need."
