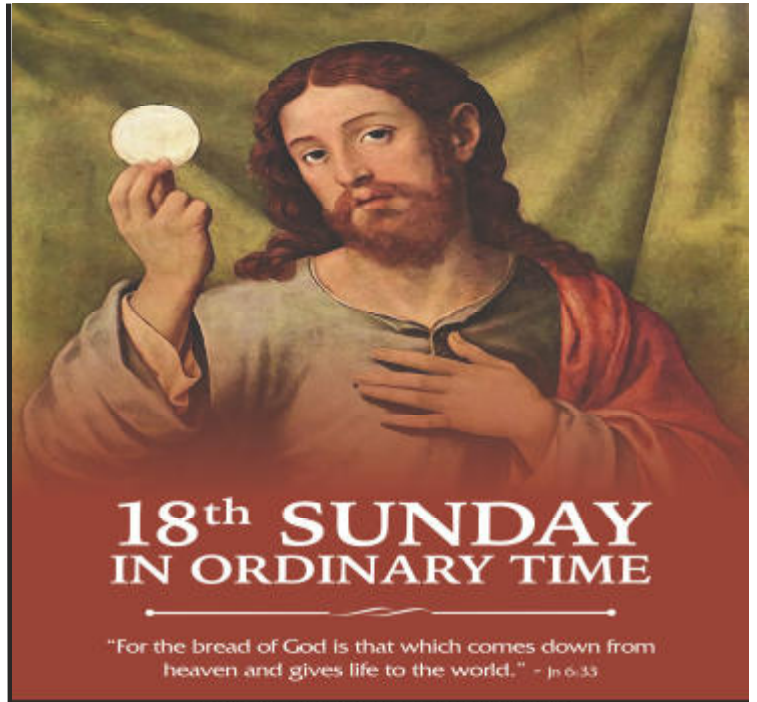

pastor's Corner

Dear family,

How do you plan your lives? For most of us we space things out or they space us out depending on how much money, food, or time we have. For many people, life is lived from moment to moment awaiting an outcome. Far too often, our ability to find time, money, resources or even food leaves so many anxious, desperate, and fearful. In today's Gospel, Jesus addresses the same crowd he fed in last weekend's Gospel. They have seen what he can do and are interested in what else he can do for them and herein lies the problem: Jesus is the prize! In a dialogue with these people, Jesus tried to get them to realize that while their bellies give them interest in his power, it is He himself who is the bread of life. Let's not misunderstand, sisters and brothers, that of course God wants us to be healthy and whole, body and soul. After all, it was Jesus himself who having compassion on the crowds made sure they were all fed. Even then, though, the main concern was that the people had no shepherd, they were spiritually orphaned. We all have needs for ourselves and our families and it should be a priority that where possible we help each other with these needs and present them before our God, but there is something deeper to be achieved here. By pointing to himself, Jesus makes himself the bread that we hunger for, relationship with him is the sustenance we all seek. To realize this is to realize that while we may be concerned about many things, we need to live on another level, where ultimately our peace and security come from our bond with God. It is that bond which gives us peace, that bond from which we draw strength to persevere in the face of difficulty, and it is this bond with our God that ultimately gives us life. What will determine your outlook or give you peace? If we are always looking to what is changing, then understandably we will always be left wanting. If we look to the embrace of God, then we will always be lifted up to meet those changing things in true peace.
