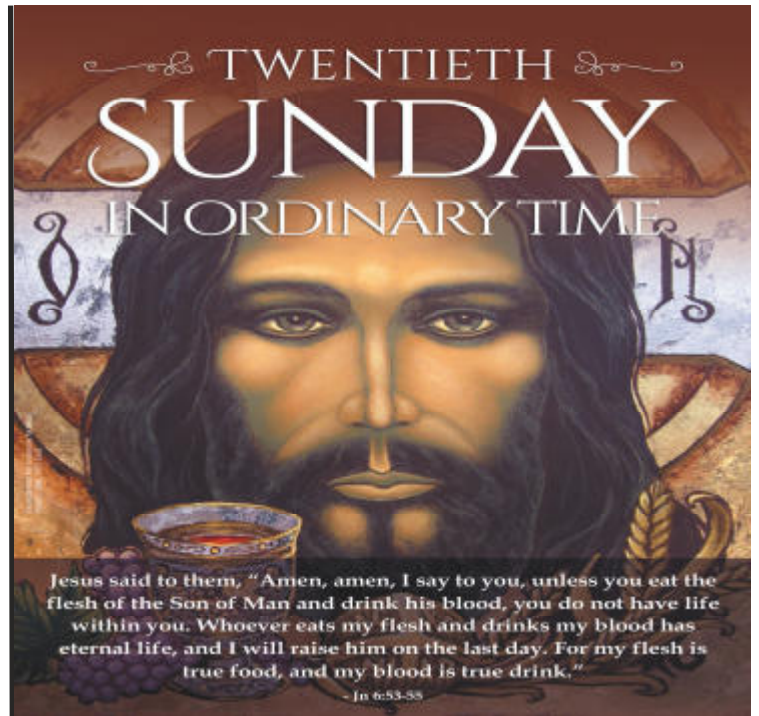

pastor's Corner

Dear family,

What's the importance of the Eucharist in your life? When a child is being prepared to receive his first communion, everything from the time spent educating him to the great pride the family takes in dressing them up and taking photographs would lead an outsider to conclude that this is a momentous occasion. Then I am sure that same outsider would be pretty confused if they had seen that in subsequent years the parents failed to take that child back to Holy Communion because they did not attend Mass themselves. I suppose this neutral outside person may ask? Well then what was the point of doing anything to begin with? Why bother? Why waste energy, time, and money? Or maybe we don't have to imagine an outsider at all, but simply consider the thoughts of the child. My family, in no way do I judge people who for whatever reason stop going to Mass or living a sacramentally rich life. But I can't help but wonder if a person's reason for leaving church out their life equation is that it was never stressed as something important to begin with or was given momentary importance and then forgotten about once everyone has commented on the posts and the cake was gone. In today's Gospel, Jesus continues to stress the importance of the Eucharist, His Body and Blood which is true food and true drink. He expresses how this sacrament is a sign and a reality of unity with Him and the Father. The life contained in this sacrament nourishes people and quenches their thirst for hope and love. Maybe it's high time we look again at the importance the Eucharist in our lives once more. I am not talking only about a ritual or even just Mass as an obligation we do or don't fulfill; I am speaking about a font of life that we are invited to drink freely from. I am speaking about a gift from God and a lifeline that can be drawn from as we deal with a life that is anything but easy. What is the importance of the Eucharist in your life?
