pastor's Corner

Dear family,

Is there any experience more wondrous for a child and more enjoyable for an adult to behold than the excitement of Christmas morning. There is a feeling in the air so magical that it feels as almost anything can happen or is possible. The lack of worry and the absence of presumption make for a time of anticipation instead of laden with sorrows. I believe this is not far off from what Our Lord was asking for in today's Gospel. Not only a praise of children, Jesus is making this requirement of hear and mind for all people: be childlike. So often to please and I press others, we feel compelled to put on a facade to convey our intelligence, beauty, and ability; we dare not acknowledge our weaknesses. And yet, the child is first of all vulnerable and humble, this meekness is the gateway to learning and to faith. We also tend to over analyze and carry our presumption wherever we go. A child just waits to see what will happen, believing only that anything can happen. Jesus' ability to heal, teach, and transform us only is possible when we decide we are not the main authority in our lives. Our Lord is not just calling actual children to Himself, but the child in all of us. He wants vulnerability, hopefulness, openness, and willingness. The next time you go to pray or pray the Mass, try approaching the moment as a child on Christmas morning, you may be surprised at what you receive!
