## Pastor's Corner

Dear family,

If you are like me, authority is not always the easiest reality to deal with. I even sometimes feel nervous when I am driving in front of a police car. With hands gripped tightly on the wheel, I make sure all things are equal so those lights don't come on. Is it any wonder your pastor joined the hierarchy of the Catholic Church? For many reasons, "authority" has been considered by many a bad word. When people hear it, they automatically think of an oppressive force over them. But what's the alternative, no rules at all? Jesus seemed to understand the problem. As God's Word, He had no qualms about speaking of God's law and the standard we are all called to live by. On the other hand, he wanted those he put in authority to understand it in a different way. While there are rules and those in charge, they are not meant to oppress, but to serve and build up. Our Lord knew well the tendency for power to corrupt people and institutions, and so He made clear how his authorities would carry out their duties and what they were about. He stated clearly, that they are first and foremost called to be servants, personally invested in those entrusted to them. "It shall not be so among you..." The purpose of being given authority is to protect God's people and the mysteries He has entrusted them with. It's a different way of looking at leadership and authority, but Jesus made it clear, it is God's way of doing things and it is not up for negotiation.
