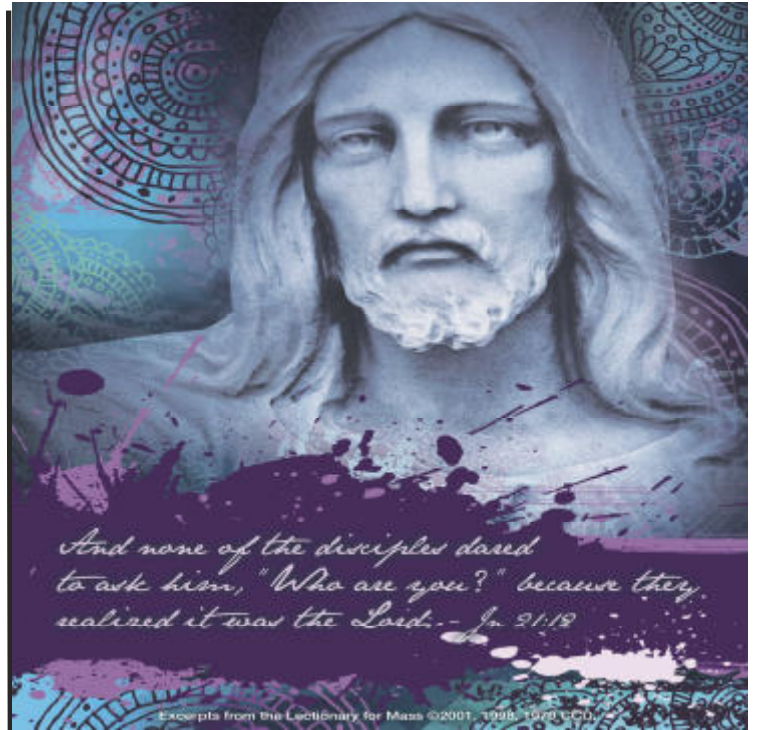

## Padre's Corner

### Dear Family,

Whose voice do you listen to? "Me? No one! I do want I want to do." Many of us would like to think a lot of what we do is original, but one would be surprised at the amount of voices that weigh in on their lives. We listen to experts on radio and television. We take in so much in that precious time scrolling on social media. We eventually even listen to our parents' advice on many things. Jesus today reminds us that a mark of a true disciple is that we ultimately recognize, listen to and heed His voice. "My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me." Take the example of Paul and Barnabas, we know it was God's voice that encouraged them and sustained them. In Antioch, a city that would one day see many other great Catholic teachers, they are taken on an emotional rollercoaster. On the one hand they have practically the entire town turning out to hear them and seem inspired by their preaching, on the other hand many Jewish leaders in their jealousy do not stop persecuting them until they drive them out of town. For anyone this would be a trial, but for those who listen to the voice of others or base their worth off how thing turn out, this would be a devastating turn of events, some would even consider it a defeat. But instead of acting defeated, they dust themselves off and go to the next town. We are told "they were filled with joy and the Holy Spirit." Clearly these individuals were not seeking only public acclaim nor were they too attached to any plans they had. The voice of the Master in their hearts continued to call them to preach and they continued to follow. In these times it is not easy to be a Christian. While we make a difference in our commitment to speak the Good News to others, there will always be some who out of jealousy or ignorance, will seek to cut us down. Don't listen to those voices, because only one will ever encourage you, only one will give you joy, and only one really matters.
