Dear Family,

We are now five weeks into Easter and we have witnessed our Lord journeying with us, finally entering our suffering and death only rise again over both. Has the power of this act of God hit us? Has it affected how we live our daily lives? Are we still living as slaves to our fears and insecurities or do we live the freedom of the sons and daughters of God? Our second reading gives us such beautiful images of this freedom, a freedom won for us by Jesus' death and resurrection. St. John receives a glorious vision of heaven where there is no suffering of any sort and Jesus Himself gives a splendid message "Behold, I make all things new." This is the power of the resurrection, dear family. Though we are only journeying toward our heavenly homeland, we have still witnessed the promise of our hope as coming true by His resurrection. We already follow a God who has conquered sin and death, we already enjoy the knowledge and support of His grace that can take the worst of the worst and bring good out from it.
