**Padre’s Corner**

Dear Family,

This is a hectic time for many people, probably not usually considered a peaceful time. Graduations, confirmations, weddings and not to mention ordinations. We are happy for our young people who will now take a new step toward a bright future, but the planning is enough to make any sane person lose his/her mind. Parents work extra hard to reward their child’s achievements, future spouses to express their love with receptions and nice venues, and everyone completely freaking out that everything goes perfectly well. Then there are emotions, don’t even get me started there. Ah, to have some peace and quiet, to be on a lake somewhere with a cold beer in hand and maybe a fishing pole. No doubt that is a great experience, but it’s fleeting. There will certainly come another event to plan, another deadline to meet and another thing that we can worry about. “Peace I leave you, my peace I give you.” Our Lord promises His disciples peace in a hectic time. He lets them know of His return to the father and the coming of this “Advocate.” The apostles are in an awkward place and I’m sure if we could listen in they are full of questions: “How will we run this Church?” They don’t have a manual, they don’t possess a lot of resources, they don’t even have smartphones or a phone system at all!
