Seminarian's Corner

Dear Family,

Today we celebrate the solemnity of Pentecost, the time when the Holy Spirit came down on the Apostles and our Blessed Mother and granted them the gift of tongues so that they may go out and preach the Gospel to all nations. This solemnity is a perfect time for us to appreciate the power and grace that the Holy Spirit gives to all of us, as long as we are open to Him and trust in His guidance. The first reading of the mass tells this story about the descent of the Holy Spirit and the great impact it had on all the disciples, who now have the grace to preach to everyone the good news of Christ's resurrection. They were given this because of their openness and trust in our Lord who desired them to share His message to show others the beauty of God's love. The apostles are excellent examples for us today who walked by faith especially after Christ ascended into Heaven. We live in such hard times today and it is certainly challenging to live good Christian lives and share the faith with others. That is why we trust and pray for the grace from the Holy Spirit to live the lives Christ calls us to as well as be able to tell others of Christ's love and the truth and authenticity of it. In the second Gospel option for Pentecost mass we hear Christ tell His disciples "The Advocate, the Holy Spirit whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you." This great feast day is the perfect opportunity for us to take these words to heart and trust that God will certainly teach and remind us of all He has said.
