## Padre's Corner

### Dear Family,

Sunday after Sunday every Christian proclaims in unison, but as an individual, that he or she believes in Father, Son, and Holy Spirit when we recite the creed: "I believe in God, the Father Almighty..." Really, we profess this when we enter church and trace the sign of the cross over ourselves "In the name of..." It's catechism 101, and something we are taught as fundamental, but do we know how powerful of a teaching this is? Because God is revealing far more than a simple formula or giving us His calling card. The revelation of the Trinity teaches us that God is personal. Long before His incarnation, God revealed Himself to His chosen people as the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. Mysterious, yet very close, He has always shown to be a personal God who is personally interested in our lives and in our ups & downs. God knows us and wants us to know Him in the details of our lives, like in any relationship of trust and confidence. God revealing Himself as Trinity is also a revelation of the importance of community for Him and us. If the all-powerful God is a community, then what does that say about us who search for meaning and purpose in our lives? It says that we don't have to do this alone. The needs, our innermost needs for intimacy, meaning, and confidence, are not to be found in ourselves alone, but in relationship with others who we need. In a more and more lonely and narcissistic world, it is a comfort that we realize we were not meant to go this journey of life alone, not at all. In the Trinity is a safe place, where each Divine Person is built up and honored, not in competition, but in love. And, of course, isn't love the great lesson of God for us, including in the Trinity?! Many of us have known heartache and have experienced the hurt in our relationships brought on by betrayal, abuse, and abandonment. The Trinity is an example, a living example of what a relationship should be, especially in the sometimes-tender area between parents and their children. The Father loves the Son and Son motivated by the same pure love obeys the Father and both fulfill their roles with no jealousy and no drama! To love well is what God does and when we seek to do the same, He, the Trinity, God Himself is made present and transforms the world. This is the true revelation and power of the Trinity and of our baptism, let us love well, dear family.
