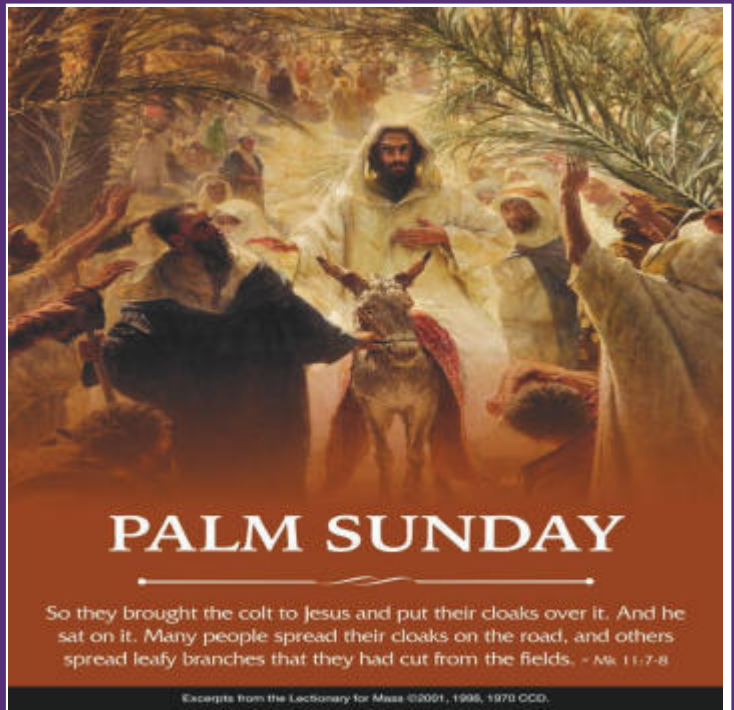

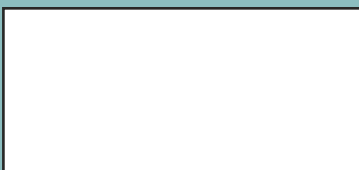

**Padre's Corner**

*“Christ Jesus, though he was in the form of God, did not regard equality with God something to be grasped.”*

Dear family,  
What do you hold dear to you? Whether or not we're aware of it, there are things we deem "essential" because of our values. If we value the praise of others, then we hold a tight grasp on our appearance and reputation. If we value material goods, then we might value high account numbers and designer clothes. As we enter the high holy days of our faith, the readings make clear what Jesus does not value. Unlike our first parents and their quest to possess power, which set history on a course away from God's love and truth, Jesus (whose power is without compare) does not "grasp" onto it. In other words, Jesus' highest value has nothing to do with His abilities, but His capacity to receive and give true love. He willingly gives up any authority in order that we might know freedom, joy, and love. In the days ahead, as we again hear the climax of this great story, we would do well to ask ourselves: What do I grasp onto that keeps me from knowing true life? We, His body, are asked to follow suit by taking the same approach to everything that does not lead to redemption. As we follow Jesus from the Last Supper to Easter morning, will we sit back and listen to yet another rendition of a familiar story or will we loosen our grasp on what keeps us from flying?

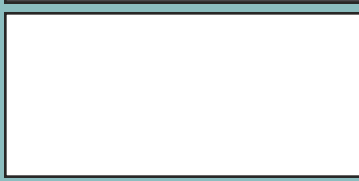

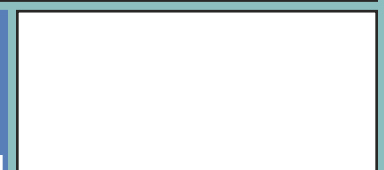
