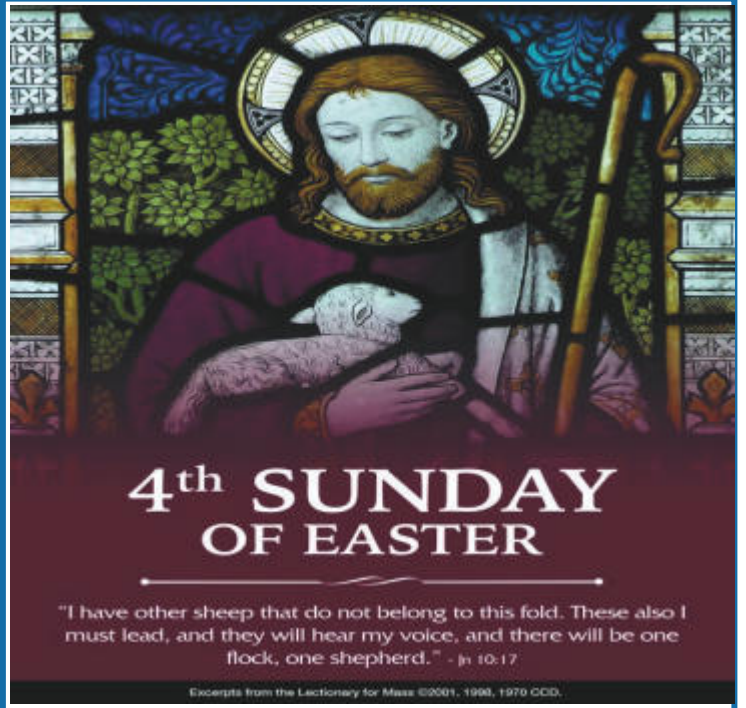

## Padre's Corner

Dearest family,

On this day of the calendar, the Fourth Sunday of Easter, the Church traditionally refers to as "Good Shepherd Sunday." This is because the Gospel selection is always taken from the tenth chapter of John's Gospel where Jesus refers to His role (and ultimately His heart) as that of a shepherd. But in describing His role we should recognize a few things that at first glance may escape us. Firstly, in the description itself, "I am the good shepherd," is a clue about God's leadership style. Above us in every way, Jesus clearly does not take on the world's conception of a superior, but rather one who personally guides and is caught up in the "thick of things" with us. Christ is not a CEO looking to be recognized for charity work, but one invested in His work (us) not afraid of smelling like the sheep. Secondly, Jesus makes a distinction between His shepherding and that of the "hired man." In other words, Christ is not a functionary, nor is He driven by sheer duty or by an eye on reward for His work. The work is the reward and is done with a full heart! Protecting us from danger, including as many into His fold as possible, Jesus makes it clear to us, His sheep, that we are cared for in a complete way. So, ask yourself, are you willing to follow your Good Shepherd? Because Jesus is willing to do the work.

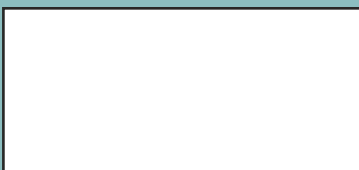

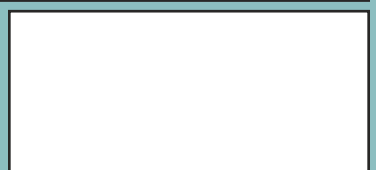
