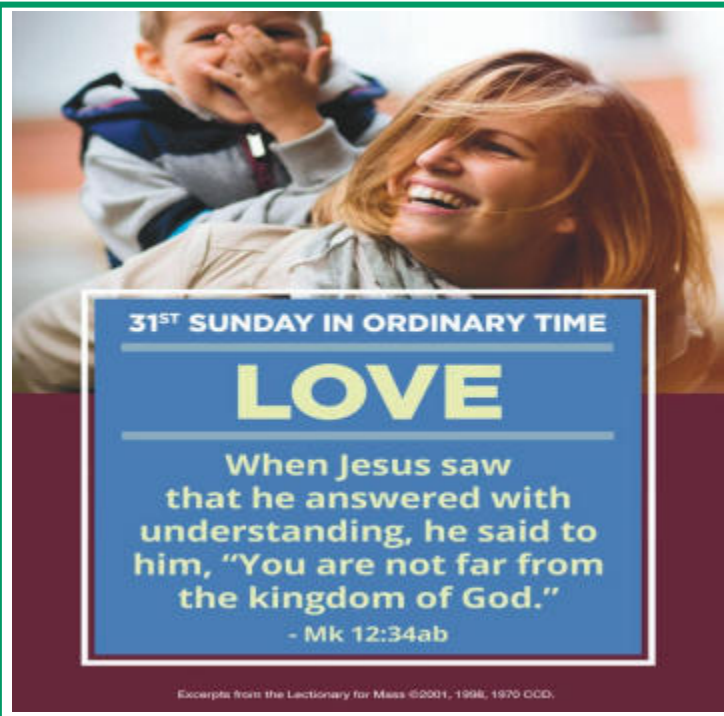

Padre's Corner


Dear family,

There are many reasons for making and following laws. Traffic laws were developed and should be followed for general safety in our travels to and from. Laws against theft are meant to respect the rights of others to property and to deter criminal activity. But God's laws are special in that while they are similar to other laws in so many ways, they have one primary reason for existing and for adherence: love! In today's Gospel Jesus references what would have been a familiar passage to a scribe looking for the most important of God's law. Jesus points out that unconditional love and God and neighbor is the highest law. The scribe agrees and adds that following this simple principle is worth more than all offering and sacrifices, in other words, without God's love in the equation, all other laws lose their meaning purpose. You see God's law is about receiving and giving love by the shape of our lives. And this love is practiced not just to avoid problems or organize our lives, but to help us become who we were born to be. In other words, living God's law is about embracing our identity as those made in His image and likeness, He who is love! God's law is about embracing our true nature and our most powerful gift, to love fully and selflessly. To live well, in God's sight, is to love well. St. John of the Cross, the Spanish priest, mystic, and poet put it best when he said, "In the evening of life, we shall be judged by how well we have loved."


