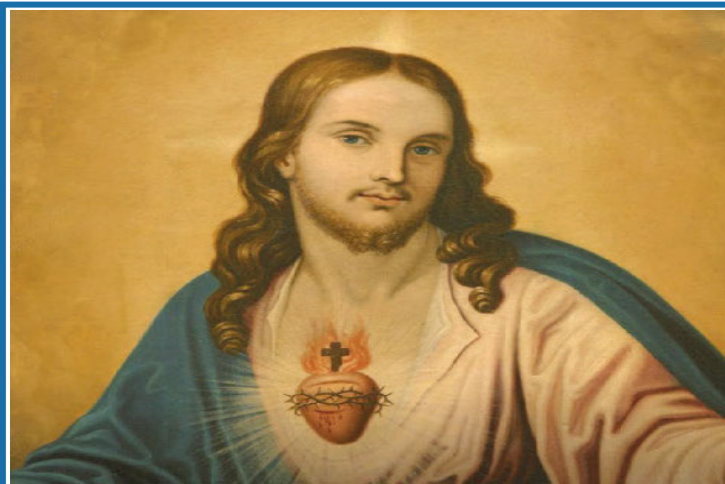

Padre's Corner

Dear family,

As we arrive at the end of another liturgical year, we are asked the same question by the Church. Is Christ our king? In terms of earthly leadership, any head of state has his/her power justified by some means. Some come to power by military success, others by birthright. Jesus shows Himself in the Gospels, however, a very different type of leader. Of any king, He has the most justifiable reasoning (historically and influentially): He's God! But if you notice in this brief exchange with Pontius Pilate (a recognized earthly leader) Jesus never asserts His authority over Pilate. This is because Jesus wants us to recognize his kingship from our own free will. In other words, we must be the one to crown Him in our hearts. The journey of faith has always been one of relationship and so we can use this opportunity to reflect on this past liturgical year, have we fostered our relationship with God. Have we grown in intimacy with Him in our prayer life and in the sacraments? Have we listened attentively to His voice guiding our actions big and small? It's all good and fine to acknowledge God's rightful place, but unlike other leaders, He's primarily seeking an enthronement in our hearts which is born from trust, love, and devotion. And those things are built up in relationship. As we embark soon on another liturgical year, let's invite Him in to take His rightful place as our creator, redeemer, and most intimate friend.
