United in Love—United in Christ

United in Love—United in Christ is a six session marriage enrichment series that explores God's plan and promise for spouses especially through the teachings of St. John Paul II's *Theology of the Body*. The program was created by Jason and Elise Angelette of the Faith and Marriage apostolate. They are joined in presenting the video content by multiple witness couples.
