



Updated Covid-19 safety protocols you need to know when attending St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Parish in person

We're so glad you'll be joining us in person!

In light of the most recent changes regarding Covid-19 guidelines, and based on Archbishop Jackel's instruction allowing parishes to make Covid-19 safety protocol updates as necessary, effective immediately, the following protocols will apply:

- For those fully vaccinated, masks are not required.
- For those not fully vaccinated, or those who feel more comfortable wearing a mask, you are encouraged to do so.
- Pews will no longer be roped off; therefore, all pews will be utilized to seat parishioners.
- While distributing Holy Communion, Eucharistic Ministers will wear masks.
- Be mindful of social distancing between others not in your immediate household.
- The Holy Water Font will be in use again.

Reservations are not required to attend Mass in person and with the increase in vaccinations and decrease in positivity rates, we are no longer taking temperatures at the door.
