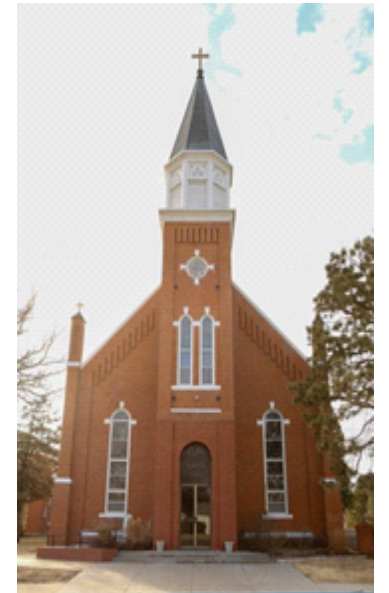

FEAST OF THE ANNUNCIATION: March 25th is the Feast of the Annunciation but is celebrated this year on April 4th (because of Good Friday), when Jesus was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit. Nine months later, he was born on Christmas. Next week will begin a series of bulletin messages about the development of the child in the womb - just like the development of Jesus in Mary's womb. Together, we will learn of the miracle of our earliest days of life.
