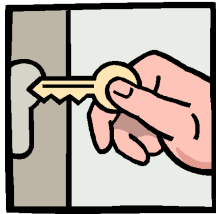

*Theme: Give as God gives - in humility and love.*

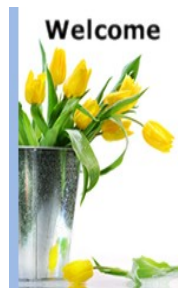
**Adult Question:** Who are the people living near you that you would find it most difficult to invite to a meal in your home? Or to invite to be part of your life?
