As many of you already know, I will start emailing every week the Ministry schedule for the next Sunday as a reminder! Hope this helps!

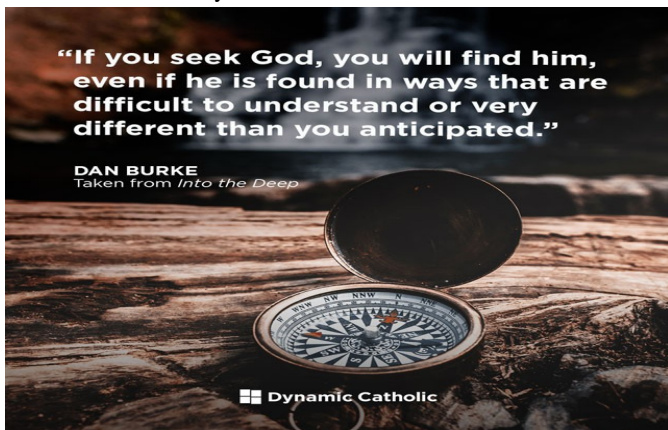
