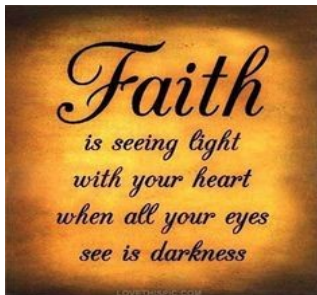
KNIGHTS BREAKFAST: There is breakfast today, right after Mass ~ all are welcome ~ free will donation!
