**MISSION CO-OP APPEAL:** Today we will hear from Sr. Rita Schwarzenberger, a Dominican Sisters of Peace, Great Bend, KS to benefit Hope for the Village Child Foundation.

Sr. Rita was born & raised in Collyer, KS and has served in Nigeria since 1975, where she took up the work of directing the Hope for the Village Child Foundation.

She and others work among and with both Christians and Muslims and they have representatives of both faiths on staff. As an organization they try to witness to others that as people of different denominations and faith, & different ethnic groups, they can work together in harmony.

Their work is mainly in rural interior communities, though they do have a central clinic. Health care is a very big issue. In our clinic as well as in outreach programs, they deal with immunization against childhood diseases, such as malaria, typhoid, tuberculosis, sickle cell disease, HIV, meningitis and other common diseases.
