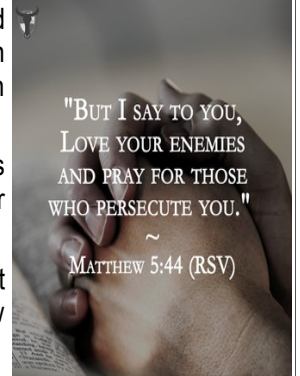
Question of the Week
