CORONAVIRUS DIRECTIVES: Bishop Vincke has put out directives in regard to the Coronavirus that we will put into effect immediately, just in case you didn't get the email that I sent out - here they are:

- *Drain the water fonts - water bowls have been removed!
- *Suspend the exchange of sign of peace
- *Suspend the distribution of the Precious Blood during Holy Communion
- *Suspend the distribution of Holy Communion on the tongue
- *All those who serve at the altar should wash their hands thoroughly before and after Mass
- *Fr. John will be prudent about shaking hands
- *If you are an extraordinary minister of Holy Communion, sanitize your hands prior to distributing communion and don't be afraid to say "no" if you are feeling under the weather!
- *No handholding during the Lord's Prayer
- *Greeters avoid handshakes
- *In general avoid all physical contact.
- *Collection baskets will be set out where the Holy Water bowls were to just drop your offering either before or after Mass.
- *And again - **IF YOU ARE SICK, PLEASE DO NOT ATTEND MASS.**

I know this might seem like a bit much, but better to be safe and take precautions. If you think of anything else, please let Daylene know and she will talk it over with Fr. John.
