**MINISTRY SCHEDULE FOR MAY:** Through the month of May and maybe into June, the only Liturgical ministers that we will be using is one Lector and one Server.

Hand sanitizer will be by the offering baskets. Disinfecting wipes are in each bathroom, please use after you use the restroom - parents, please go with your child and make sure the disinfecting wipes are used.

We will have the Lector read both readings and the petitions. We will not be having a choir, I will be cantering, so I will do the Responsorial Psalms and Gospel Acclamation as well as leading other songs.

We will use only one server as there is not room to keep everyone six feet apart. The server will not have any interaction with other people other than Fr. John.

The gifts will not be brought up and offering will not be taken up by our ushers - there are baskets where the Holy Water use to sit, please put your offering in the basket either as you come into church or as you are leaving. If you feel more comfortable mailing your offering in, that is also fine. Don't forget, you can go into the Diocese website: [www.salinadiocese.org](http://www.salinadiocese.org) and donate online as well.

There will only be one line for communion, and Fr. John will distribute communion. He is only distributing in the hand until further notice. We will have one pew from one side go and then followed by a pew on the other side and respecting the 6 ft. social distancing.

**MASKS AVAILABLE:** There are masks in the main offering basket that is on top of the new mailboxes that are free for the taking. If I see they are getting low then I will make more. Again, if you know someone who needs one, you just need to ask - I have no problem making them - I have plenty of material - so please ask!

**SUNDAY MASS INSTRUCTIONS cont.:** Communion time will probably take a bit longer, so please be patient.

Please, I am asking that everyone please not arrive at 8:30 a.m., please come early. I will be seating everyone as they come for this first time back. Once you are seated I will have a blank piece of paper in the pew and I ask that you put your name on it. This will be where you and your family will be sitting until further notice. You may not be sitting in your normal spot, but again please be understanding. Bulletins will also be placed in the pews.

When you are leaving, please make sure that you are social distancing and use the blue lines that I have put on the floor.

If you come to Sunday Mass and daily Mass, please sit in the same pew. If you are only coming to daily Mass, please sit in the pew that doesn't have blue painters tape on it, and use this pew until further notice. Pews will be cleaned, but by doing this, hopefully the books will only be touched by you and your family.

Kids Mailboxes: please do not congregate at the mailboxes, as we are unable to keep our distance. But, don't be surprised if you find something in your pew for your little one in the weeks to come! It won't happen this weekend, as I won't know where you will be sitting!

I know that this is a first for us, and I know it is hard and I guess that what we need to keep in mind is that by social distancing we are protecting us and our families.

Last, I want to remind our parishioners who are over 60 or have underlying health conditions to please stay home (maybe a daily Mass would be better for you!) If you are sick in any way, please stay home. Masks are encouraged, but not required and if you need a mask, there are some in the back of church.
