A brief history: Heralds of Good News (HGN) is a Clerical Missionary Society of Apostolic life of Pontifical right, whose principal seat is established in the Diocese of Eluru (AP) in India and was founded by Rev. Fr. Jose Kaimlett on October 14, 1984. It was erected as a diocesan right on May 1991 and being recognized as a pontifical right on May 5, 1999.

The society has a charism that is unique to itself of *“training and supplying zealous and saintly priests wherever there is need in the Universal Church, especially due to the shortage of local vocations.”*

In order to make the administration run smooth, the society has been formed into five provinces. There are five priests from this Order working in our diocese of Salina.

The main focus of our ministry in India and other countries is: Our ministry embraces all aspects of Jesus’ mission. Parish Ministry, Education Ministry with special concentration on the poor and financially challenged, Prison Ministry, Retreat Centers for Spiritual Renewal of the faithful, establishing Orphanages for social emancipation of poor children to ensure a bright future and new evangelization through mass media communication.
