HOLY LAND COLLECTION: This year, due to the pandemic, it was not possible to take up the Good Friday Collection dedicated to supporting Christians living in the Land of Jesus. This is why Pope Francis accepted our request to move this gesture of sharing that concerns the whole Church to this weekend.

The date was chosen because this is the Sunday Closest to the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, which is celebrated with particular solemnity in Jerusalem. On this feast we remember how far the love of the Son of God has come for us: giving His life on the Cross for our salvation and reconciling us to the Father and to each other. This gives birth to a new Humanity founded on solidarity and love.
