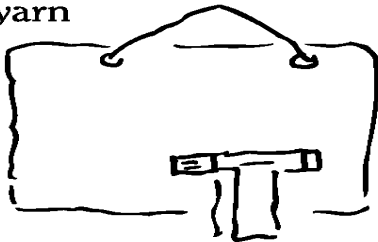
## MAKE A REMINDER BOARD

*Sometimes we need something to help us remember things.*

*A Reminder Board can help.*

### *You will need:*

- ✍ a piece of cardboard (one side of a cereal box works well)
- ✍ white or colored contact paper
- ✍ a hole punch
- ✍ scissors
- ✍ clothes pin (the kind with a spring)
- ✍ glue
- ✍ wipe-off marker
- ✍ yarn



### *How to make it:*

1. Cut the contact paper a little larger than the cardboard.
2. Stick the contact paper to the cardboard, folding the edges over to the back.
3. Punch 2 holes at the top.
4. Tie yarn to the holes to make a hanger.
5. Glue the clothes pin to the front. When dry, it will hold the marker.
6. Write notes on your new reminder board!
