DISTRIBUTION OF ASHES: Immaculate Conception is following Bishop Vincke's strong suggestion to follow the directive from Rome regarding the distribution of ashes this year. The following is what Bishop Vincke wrote:

The rationale for it, of course is to avoid repetitive physical contact with different people and to speak fewer words directly into their faces. These are avoided by pronouncing the words "Remember that you are dust..." or "Repent and believe in the Gospel" once over the entire assembly, and by sprinkling ashes over their heads instead of smearing them on their foreheads.

It is good to note that many countries have always sprinkled the ashes in this manner. We might be more in sync with the rest of the Church by doing this. The Old Testament describes various instances where people put on sackcloth and sat in ashes or poured ashes over themselves (see Jonah 3:5; Esther 4:1; Job 2:8 and others).


