Summer marches on! It was incredibly hot this week, which is a reminder to us all not only to stay hydrated but also to take special care to check in with our elderly who live alone. So, if you know a senior member of our parish who lives alone, take a couple of minutes out of your day a couple of times this week to just ask, "I was just wondering how you are managing in this heat. Is everything OK with you?"

I had the opportunity on this past Monday to have lunch with the Vietnamese Redemptorist priests, including our new Sacramental minister, Father Joseph Toan Lai. He is anxious to get moved to Las Vegas and to get working at St. Andrew. One of the things I asked him is what his preference is about how we address him: Fr. Joseph, Fr. Toan, or Father Lai. The common first name he has been called his whole life is Toan (pronounced Twahn), so he said he would prefer that. We'll practice that together a time or two before he gets here. Though his English name is Joseph he doesn't want to be called by that since our Bishop has the same first name.

Fr. Toan is 35 years old, but looks much younger to me. That might be in part because now that I'm in my 60's everyone looks much younger to me! He likes sports but when I asked about Hockey he said that

because he has lived in Houston since age 11 he just was never exposed to Hockey. He has a degree in Information Technology and is the youngest in his family.

His family has farmed mint in the Houston area, so he has also had the experience of working in the field and the other aspects of bringing a crop to market. When I asked what he thought of our heat he said that he had spent his deacon year in Tucson, so he's already familiar with the dry heat of the desert and doesn't think he will have any difficulty adapting.

We'll look forward to formally welcoming him to St. Andrew on July 16th as we celebrate our transitions--my leaving as resident pastor, Deacon Tim's serving as Parish Life Coordinator, and our new, non-resident Sacramental Minister, Fr. Toan.

A couple people have asked why the term "Sacramental Minister," and that simply designates a priest who will have the responsibilities of the celebration of the sacraments without the other usual responsibilities that a Pastor or Parochial Vicar has. Those other responsibilities will be filled by our Parish Life Coordinator, Deacon Tim.

Stay hydrated and look in on our seniors who live alone. Blessings, Fr. Bob
