Message from Deacon Tim

As we are all aware the devastation of Hurricane Harvey left vast areas underwater with thousands of people still stranded and more than 100,000 homes have been flooded.

Bishop Pepe has called on all parishes to take up a special collection **September 9-10** to support victims of Hurricane Harvey and to provide pastoral and rebuilding support to impacted dioceses.

Pope Francis with the renewed promise of his prayers sends his blessing as a pledge of consolation, strength, and peace in the Lord.

Archbishop José H. Gomez of Los Angeles, vice-president of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB), stated, "Our hearts and prayers go out to the families that have lost loved ones and to all who have lost homes and businesses along with their sense of peace and normalcy."

We must stand with our brother and sisters, and their pastors and bishops in the region who have the difficult task of providing pastoral care during this crisis while managing their own losses. Although all our prayers are needed our financial support is urgently needed.

Funds given to the collection will support the humanitarian and recovery efforts of Catholic Charities USA and will provide pastoral and rebuilding support to impacted dioceses through the USCCB. The hurricane has affected southeast Texas, including the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston and Louisiana.
