Deacon Tim's Reflection

Today's Gospel is not about making money and turning a profit in dollars and cents, rather, I would submit it's really about the gifts and talents that God has given us. The gifts and talents God has provided us are intended to be used wisely and generously to build the Kingdom of God.

Last week we had our first signups for Altar Servers, young people 16 and under who have received the Sacraments of Baptism and First Communion were invited to sign up, and only three kids did so. I overheard one parent suggest to a child that there wasn't enough time to be an Altar Server. Which might explain why we don't have them now in our parish. Perhaps, not having enough participation is the reason the ministry was discontinued. I certainly don't have that history to say so. However, being an Altar Server doesn't take a great deal of time only a bit of commitment. Your children are gifts from God which should not be hidden such as the Talent hidden by the slave, and these children also have gifts and talents from God which should be put to use to advance the Kingdom of God.

The children of our parish aren't just the future of the Church they are the now.

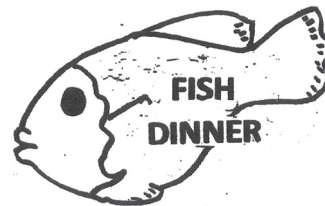
THIS Wednesday, November 22nd THANKSGIVING MASS 7 PM
